The Education Inspection Framework and the role of the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)

About this course:

- ▶ Investigate current inspection issues that appear with frequency in inadequate and RI inspection reports, enabling you to identify potential vulnerabilities in current practice so that you can address them before your next inspection event.
